English Conversation for Physicists

This course is designed for students who have had some formal instruction in the English language and wish to become conversant in English as appropriate to physicists. Students will be expected to contribute actively in an informal non-critical atmosphere. The course should be particularly appropriate for students planning to be participate in projects abroad where familiarity with English is assumed or taking part in international workshops or conferences. This is a course in conversational English and NOT a course in formal English.

While the emphasis will be on active participation in conversations relating to physics I plan to also discuss topics such as:-

- 1. Writing scientific papers for publication in international journals.
- 2. Preparing Posters for conferences and workshops.
- 3. Giving research seminars.
- 4. Preparation of curriculum vitae.
- 5. Finding information.
